Administration Reports

Principal's Report

- Student presentation/request: garden- request from grade 7 leadership team for their coordinated effort. There is a line of \$300 in the budget, which we are inviting the team to use. The team is also invited to approach Meadow Landscaping and they have approached Triple Tree.
- In spite of weather, students have settled back in. Weather impeded outdoor play today, and hoping for melt so that kids can go outside.
- Assembly last week to review expectations
- Pro-D yesterday: teachers rotated through stations. Money will be infused into schools, at PME it will mean a 1.0FTE teacher. Teachers spent time discussing how best to use this teacher to collaborate and assist learning (ie. Reading groups, reading assessments, math support). It will work out to approx. 10hours per teacher. Going forward: the structure of the school will be a challenge as the space is all currently being used. A change to class size and composition may make class building a challenge. In addition, teachers explored the new curriculum: First Nations Principles; ADST; community-building projects (celebrating Canada).
- Money was raised for kitchen supplies and leadership initiative at the Christmas Concert.
- Requests by teachers: for Robotics the district purchasing is trying to find the BB8 features in a less expensive model; Saleema Noon- there will be \$2500 available, and we would like to include a parent-info night; Science Alive (May) request- \$800 from us and \$2 per student (thought that there may be some room in the 'presentation' budget)
- Looking back through the records, it looks as though the PAC bills may add up to \$4000. With that in mind, the budget does not have room for extra spending right now. Going forward: we would like to have all receipts in by an annual deadline (July 31), and we can consider putting a lump sum in an office account so that they can control classroom funds. We are reluctant to commit to bigger spending items.

- Longterm plan: was to have a screen installed then the projector later. The installation cost came in higher than expected; and there will be a cost associated with projector installation. The school has used some funds for purchasing the projector, and may need money for installation.
- Clothing drive- grade 7's are invited to run as a fundraiser

- Wheelchair basketball can we support again, we will see amounts available in the presentation account and money returned to kitchen. Payment does not need to be made until they present, but presentation will be booked.
- Website went live last week, any feedback?
- Strategic Planning: short-term- to spend gaming within time frame (ADST, other), emergency food items, stage curtains; mid/long-term- tents, tarps, buckets and shovels, hygiene items for emergency; playground equipment (district will cover safe landing space)
