### Health & Safety Report (Eileen Hurlbert/Marcella Boggio)

- Based on conversations high priority items: 1.high energy food bars (ordered and received) for the 20% projected to be left for up to 48 hours. They are good for 5 years.
  Blankets- there are 6 per backpack- good for 20%. It has been recommended that we have 1 blanket per child. If we increase the blanket supply to 100% the cost is \$869.75.
  Water- there are 30 packages of water in each class backpack which are each 125mL. The provincial standard is 4L of water per person per day. The small packages are not the best option at this amount. We can consider a water-filtration system and have extra filters on hand. A suggestion for rainbarrels to collect water that could be filtered.
- We can send a information letter and a request for donations to families. We can send it out with the next newsletters, in addition to a half-page home. Eileen will put in recommendations from the district and statistics, and some of the examples of costs.
