Motion by Eileen Hurlbert, seconded by Rachel Hess. Approved.

Review & Acceptance of previous meeting minutes

Motion to accept minutes by Kelly Job, seconded by Susan Caldwell. Approved.

Administration Reports

Principal's Report

o Deferred to teachers: Miss Toupin & Mrs. White. Hoping to take students to Camp Jubilee this year and they are looking for fundraising opportunities/ideas so that they're not duplicating the efforts of the PAC. Kelly offered up opportunity of face painting at Carnival in February. They could run a face painting room. Poinsettas. Have a list of things they've considered: hot dog day, Freezie day, pointsettas & Purdy's chocolates. Babysitting during movie nights. Cash for clothing from Developmental Disabilities association. Bottle drive. Planning on doing camp from May 15-17 so will stop fundraising in early April.

o Start up – very smooth this year. All classes very full. 586 kids this year. Middle portable is being used as a multipurpose room this year. New secretary: Stacy, this is her first job as head elementary secretary.

o No update on emergency plan information. Container/bin will still be placed in same position but no news on bin security, list of contents etc. DPAC meeting will still cover some of this: bulk buying options. Is there district insurance that will cover this? Will not be over and above what the district already have...won't have specific container insurance. Falls under current policy.

o Gavin Laird had a question about lead paint testing and water quality testing. Are these reports available for parents to see? Quoting a Maple Ridge NEWS article from May 27th. Stephanie will look into getting the contents of the

report that was mentioned by School Board Trustee Mike Murray.

- o New pilot program that will be starting: organics program. This school will be part of the pilot program (4 schools in total participating at this time). District will be bringing in large totes for separating organics and recyclables. There will be some education on how to use these. Mrs. White's class will be in charge of pick up/management. They will be picked up twice/week to avoid issues with rodents. Will be a potential learning curve. Staff will be presented to on Sept. 29th and students will learn about this at the assembly on Oct. 7th.
- o Wanted to verify that funds for teachers were still going to be the same this year. Yes, all teachers each get \$200. 24 divisions and then each support stream plus Mr. Severud will get \$200. Motion to give the extra money: \$200. for each support stream. Kelly Job made the motion, Aimee Bilodeau seconded. Updated total for (\$200 x 27)
- o Stephanie mentioned that Pita Pit owner is still very persistent in wanting to provide lunch for a lunch fundraiser. Rachel will contact them to find out if they can do a presentation.
- o Terry Fox Run at end of the month. Still need more volunteers Stephanie has only received about 10 volunteers and need about 20 22.
 - o No news about Quebec trip grant money yet

Committee Reports

Chair Report (chaired by Kelly Job)

- o Need to come up with a School Planning Council (SPC). Need to come up with goals for the school. Will consist of Stephanie Dand, 1 teacher and 3 parents of the school. 1 parent has to be one of the elected members of the PAC. For next time, please let Kelly know if anyone would like to be that 1 parent. May have to vote at next meeting if more than 1 person is interested in the position. From Stephanie: current goals: social responsibility, literacy and accountability on the part of the kids. How big is the time commitment? Usually only 2 or 3 meetings in a year. Question from Adam: who is the school accountable for this? Yes, this is reported to the district, who then writes a district accountability plan. This includes the WITS program. Needs to be tied to the curriculum.
 - Strategic plan (Karen Leslie)- in order to align ourselves with school goal and to create our own goals as a PAC. To try and organize ourselves in order to encourage parent involvement as well as directing fundraising and spending. Karen created a mock-up plan, set up with information already available. It uses the PME mission statement, and outlines the roles of PAC. Kelly has also drafted a PAC mission statement- two edits/suggestions to move parent involvement closer to top and to add art supplies to our list of resources. Objectives are stated: short term, medium term and long term and the purposes/rationale of fundraising. Strategic planning cycle is included- when and how we revisit the plan. In addition, a list of contacts

and resources is attached. In order to edit or tweak the first version, we may want to review it as a small committee, then bring it to PAC for acceptance. Committee: Kelly, Luba, Karen, Adam and Eileen

- Eileen has looked at creating a PAC website that can be linked from the school or district sites. She will work on it, but may need committee help with the content.
- Jason Severud has passed in a letter re: Alternate Environmental Health and Physical Education. The program runs on Wednesday for all the grade 6-7's and most of the 5's. They are asking for resources for funding the program (transportation and site visits). We can ask for some resources from the community as well. If Jason can give us a number, we can look at approving all or some of it.
- Salvation Army approached the school- they provide lunches to some school populations. However, the food bank generally supplies enough food for the kids in need at our school (10-15 per day)

Treasurer's Report (Review by Aimee Bilodeau)

o PAC Budget- summarizing payments made from last year. Draft for this year- with amendments we made last year.

Motion to increase amount for presenters from \$2000 to \$2500 by Rachel Hess. Seconded by Eileen Hurlbert. Approved.

Reasoning for increase: to have Jesse Miller in for the grade 4/5s and begin alternating for that age group and to donate to Children of the street.
